


HISTORY OF THE FESTIVAL

The Ischia Film Festival was founded in 2003 within the project "Cinema and Territory", aimed to promote the cultural and landscape identity of the territories through cinematographic works.

The competition has allowed the general public to see feature films and documentaries that have opened a window on the world, rewarding those narratives that,

more than others, have managed to bring out the strength of the places where they were shot.

The Festival has reached its twentieth edition, with the promise of letting people experience the emotions of cinematographic art that take shape in the spectacular locations of Ischia, where once again, that special bond between Cinema and territory is expressed.
